

Steam - Reversible Cabled-Rib Scarf



There are two versions:

- A No edge stitch, which makes it curvy
- B Straight 3 stitch border on edge which frames cable

SIZE

Adult

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 52 inches/132 cm

Width: 5 inches

MATERIALS

- A 3 skeins (130m/50g skein) Lang Yarns Venezia - 50% Mohair, 50% Acrylic
- B 4 skeins (123 yards/50 grams ball) Knit Picks Merino Style - Fog, 100% Merino wool

1 US #5/3.75mm circular or straight needle

Cable needle

Tapestry needle

GAUGE

Not critical for this pattern - feel free to substitute yarn in your stash with the corresponding needles

Pattern is k2, p2 ribbing with a 16 stitch cable every 12th row

With tapestry needles, weave in ends.



A CO 48 STS

All Rows: work charted 48 sts from Chart
cable pattern on rows 9 & 21 of chart

Continue working chart until piece measures 52 inches or desired length

B CO 54 STS

Row 1 RS: K3, work chart sts 1-48 on Chart, k3

Row 2: Sl 1 knit-wise, k2, work charted 48sts, k3.
cable pattern on rows 9 & 21 of chart

Continue working chart, keeping first and last 3 sts in garter st and sl st first stitch of every row until piece measures 52 inches or desired length

Chart Stitch Key

K on RS, P on WS

P on RS, K on WS



16sts LC (row 9)

slip 8 sts to cable needle and hold to FRONT, [k2, p2] 2 times, work sts from cn: [k2, p2] 2 times



16sts RC (row 21)

slip 8 sts to cable needle and hold to BACK, [k2, p2] 2 times, work sts from cn: [k2, p2] 2 times

Tip: Mark the first row after your cabled row so you can count 11 regular rows before the next cabled row.

Tip: Spit splice wool or use Russian join method when adding new skein to continue without loose ends left to weave in later
